## Healthier Texas Receives \$25,000 Meta Data Center Community Action Grant to Expand AI-Powered Health Support in Bell County

The grant will help expand access to digital health tools designed to help families build healthier lives.

The investment from Meta’s Temple Data Center will support the expansion of Healthier Texas’ hybrid health coaching model, which combines **AI-powered digital tools with trusted community-based health support**.

“Community partnerships like this make it possible for us to reach families who might otherwise go without support,” said **Jamie Williams, CEO of Healthier Texas**. “Meta’s investment allows us to expand AI-powered, bilingual health coaching to Bell County residents, helping families access preventive care, nutrition guidance, and digital tools that support healthier living.

### Technology That Extends Support

Participants will have access to a **free AI-powered digital platform** that helps individuals track health goals, build routines, and stay connected with their care team between coaching sessions.

Healthier Texas’ health coaching model is supported by [Wellnify.ai](https://www.wellnify.ai), the digital platform currently powering the statewide Healthier Texas Community Challenge. This integration allows participants to track goals, log activity, and remain connected to their care team between live sessions, creating continuity across individual coaching and community-level engagement with real-time application of skills learned.

By providing no-cost access to health technology, Healthier Texas is able to expand personalized health guidance across communities while maintaining meaningful individual connections.
